Målet med EMBS er at give studerende en mulighed for at øge kendskabet til og indsigten i europæiske forhold og den måde hvorpå virksomheder agerer i det fælles europæiske marked. EMBS giver dig mulighed for at opnå det eftertragtede EMBS certifikat. Ved at læse EMBS ved siden af dine studier på SDU for du altså både din nationale kandidat grad og et fælles europæisk EMBS certifikat.

EMBS er et konsortium af Europæiske universiteter/business schools, hvis formål er at give et antal studerende mulighed for, udover deres normale kandidatgrad at erhverve sig et europæisk certifikat. Syddansk Universitet er det eneste danske medlem af dette netværk. Studerende på negot, BA-Int, merc og oecon har mulighed for at erhverve sig dette europæiske certifikat ved at tilmelde sig denne ordning, når de påbegynder deres overbygning. Kort fortalt indebærer det en merindsats på et halvt årsværk.

Krav for at læse EMBS!

Du skal have en rimelig god Bachelor eksamen, indskrevet ved SDU på en kandidatuddannelse og have gode sprogkunderskaber i engelsk og helst i et andet europæisk sprog. For at kunne få din danske kandidatgrad skal du opfylde kravene i din studieordning. Herudover er der nogle krav du skal have opfyldt for at få EMBS certifikatet;

- EMBS omfatter 120 ECTS. Normalt læses de første 60 ECTS ved SDU, svarende til det første år på kandidatdelen.
- 60 ECTS skal læses ved et andet EMBS partner universitet. Ud af disse 60 ECTS skal de 20 ECTS omfatte et europæisk modul.
- Det europæiske modul omfatter; European Core Elements: 10 ECTS, International oriented management elements: 5 ECTS, Foreign Local Elements: 5 ECTS og følges hovedsageligt på partner universitetet.
- Certifikatet kan først udstedes når du har bestået din danske kandidatafhandling.

This qualification guarantees a university education in “Business Sciences” which is particularly appropriate for companies and/or organizations operating in a European and global environment.
