Indicative Course Content

On successful completion of the summer school students will be awarded 40 Level 1 or Level 2 undergraduate credits validated by the University of Wales. These credits will give exemption from other NEWI courses if students wish to continue to study in the UK.

Subjects we plan to offer include: Marketing, Economics, Managing People and Business Strategy.

We may also be able to offer other business-related subjects to meet the needs of individual applicants (please indicate your requirements on your application form).

Assessment will be based on presentations, group discussions, short written assignments and through participation in a computerised business simulation.

Programme fees

The fee for the summer school is an all-inclusive £360 (approx €537) which includes technical tuition, accommodation and airport transfers (subject to availability). Students are required to make their own travel arrangements to the UK

Accommodation is allocated on a first come first served basis in our student village and hostel.

A £50 non-refundable deposit will secure your place, leaving a balance of £310 payable. Demand is usually high and places are limited so it is important to apply early to avoid disappointment.

We are offering:

- tuition in Business and Management subjects
- free English language tuition and support
- a chance to improve your business English
- low-cost accommodation (mainly on campus)
- free collection and return between Liverpool and Manchester International airports
- visits to local industries.

- A trip to Alton Towers, the UK's greatest theme park.
